



# Professional Photography Policy

## How to Plan a Photo Session at Emily's Produce

1. Schedule Your Session
  - a. Visit our website for Online Reservation Form, Photography Policy and Photography Agreement. [www.emilysproduce.com](http://www.emilysproduce.com)
  - b. After completing the reservation form and paying, you will need to sign and bring the Photography Agreement form with you to your chosen time slot.
2. Photography Fee:
  - a. There is a \$50 fee per hour
  - b. Available hours and dates are managed through our Reservation Form
3. Check In
  - a. All photographers must check in at the market
  - b. We will confirm you are there for your scheduled time and that we have a signed Photography Agreement on file.
  - c. You will be directed to the location you are permitted to take photos.
  - d. Restricted Zones: please be aware of restricted zones provided to you at check in. For your safety and the safety of your clients you must follow these guidelines.

## Rules to Remember

1. You must park in the parking lot
2. Pets are allowed in the Sunflower field and must be leashed at all times
3. Be courteous and respectful of our property, farm activities and customers. Props are okay. You should leave the farm in the same condition and cleanliness as when you arrived. Emily's Produce reserves the right to ask you to move or leave the premises if you are disruptive or not complying with the farm's policies.
4. Contact Emily's Produce immediately if you are unable to keep an approved **Session Appointment**.
5. Emily's Produce reserves the right to alter this policy or refuse photographer access at any time for any reason.
6. Published photos (Facebook, Instagram, Blog, web) should credit the location of the photograph (Emily's Produce, Cambridge, MD). Emily's Produce welcomes all photo submissions! If you share your photos with us, with your permission and credit, we may use them in print and/or online!
